## Derrick Dean Wagner Memorial Parishioner Scholarship

The Derrick Dean Wagner Memorial Parishioner Scholarship was established in 2012 through the generosity of St. Mark's parishioner William H. Wagner. The scholarship is a memorial for his son Derrick who was killed in 1990 by the driver of an automobile who left the scene and was neither charged nor brought to trial.

Through the funds raised from an annual train and toy exhibit, sponsored by the Derrick Wagner Foundation, a scholarship has been established to be given to a child of a St. Mark's parishioner. The scholarship recipient must fulfill the following requirements: be a communicant of St. Mark's Church; be nominated by the clergy; be entering first grade or higher; and meet the qualifications required for admission to the school.

The partial scholarship, \$750, will be applied towards tuition and financial aid from St. Mark's Episcopal Church and School may be also available for qualified families. For detailed information, pick up a scholarship information sheet in the church narthex or church office.
